Policy and Regulations for Recreational Drone Flights.

*

*Adapted for Council owned land from the Regulations of the
UK Civil Aviation Authority for small unmanned aircraft.*

- 1. The Council needs to be advised of any drone flights.
Contact the Chairman 07796 447677.*
- 2. Drone flights will be allowed in the Foal Ground Family Park
only.*
- 3. Flights can only take place during daylight hours and
during British Summer Time between 08.00 hours and 20.00
hours.*
- 4. The open space beyond the play equipment and picnic tables
should be used. If children are playing, care must be taken
to keep flights away from the play area.*
- 5. Permission from the Parish Council must be obtained if
cameras are to be fixed to the drone.*
- 6. No drone flights can be made from council property for
commercial purposes.*
- 7. The drone owner is advised to take out insurance.*
- 8. Any damage to trees, bushes or equipment in the park will be
charged to the drone owner.*

Owner's Responsibilities.

- Responsible for flying a drone in a safe manner.*
- Keep the drone in sight at all times, making sure it does not
collide with other objects.*
- Not to recklessly or negligently cause or permit a drone to
endanger any person or property.*
- Must not fly the drone at a height of more than 400 feet.*
